# Code of Conduct for Learners

Grade R - 7 parents are to please take note of the following provisions in the Code of Conduct for Learners, pages 11 & 22 of the AMPS Homework Diary:

## *Section A: School Uniform*

### Summer:

1. Girls -- official summer School uniform = School dress, white School anklets (above the ankle), standard black shoes with black shoelaces or a strap with a buckle.
2. Girls may wear navy short ski pants underneath their dresses - these may not be visible. No boxer shorts to be worn underneath the dress.
3. Learners may wear a plain navy sun hat / cap during the summer months only, but it must be taken off indoors.
4. Boys -- official summer School uniform = navy shorts, white shirt with badge, navy School socks with red / white / blue stripe, *standard black shoes with black shoelaces.*

### Winter:

5. Winter uniform is the same for both boys and girls. Long navy trousers, long sleeved white School shirt, navy School socks and standard black School shoes as per no. 1 & 4.
6. Girls may wear navy blue woolen stockings with their School dress, **during winter only.**
7. Learners may wear plain navy gloves, AMPS scarves and "beanies" in winter - however, they may not be worn indoors. No earmuffs are permitted.
8. The navy School jersey, navy drimac with badge or navy blazer with badge may be worn with the summer or winter uniform.



## Section 11: School Property

Misconduct of Learners at Public Schools and Disciplinary Proceedings:

### 8. Schedule 1

(Serious conduct that may lead to suspension)

A learner will be guilty of serious misconduct if he or she, intentionally and without just excuse-

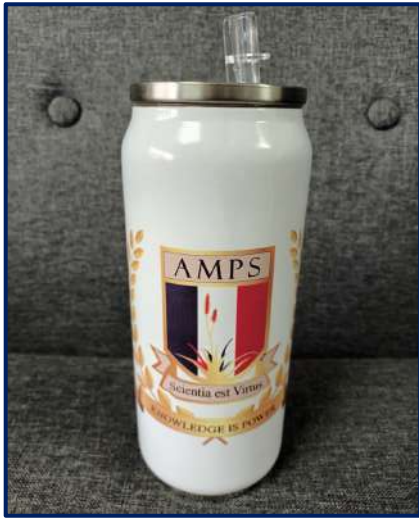
- a) seriously threatens, disrupts or frustrates teaching or learning in a class;
- b) engages in a conspiracy to disrupt the proper functioning of the School through collective action;
- c) insults the dignity of or defames any learner or any other person, which includes racist remarks;
- d) distributes, or is in the possession of any test or examination material that may enable another person to gain an unfair advantage in a test or examination;
- e) cheats in a test or examination or any other form of assessment such as assignments;
- f) engages in any act of public indecency;
- g) sexually harasses another person;
- h) is found in possession of or distributes pornographic material;
- i) is under the influence or in the possession of alcohol.
