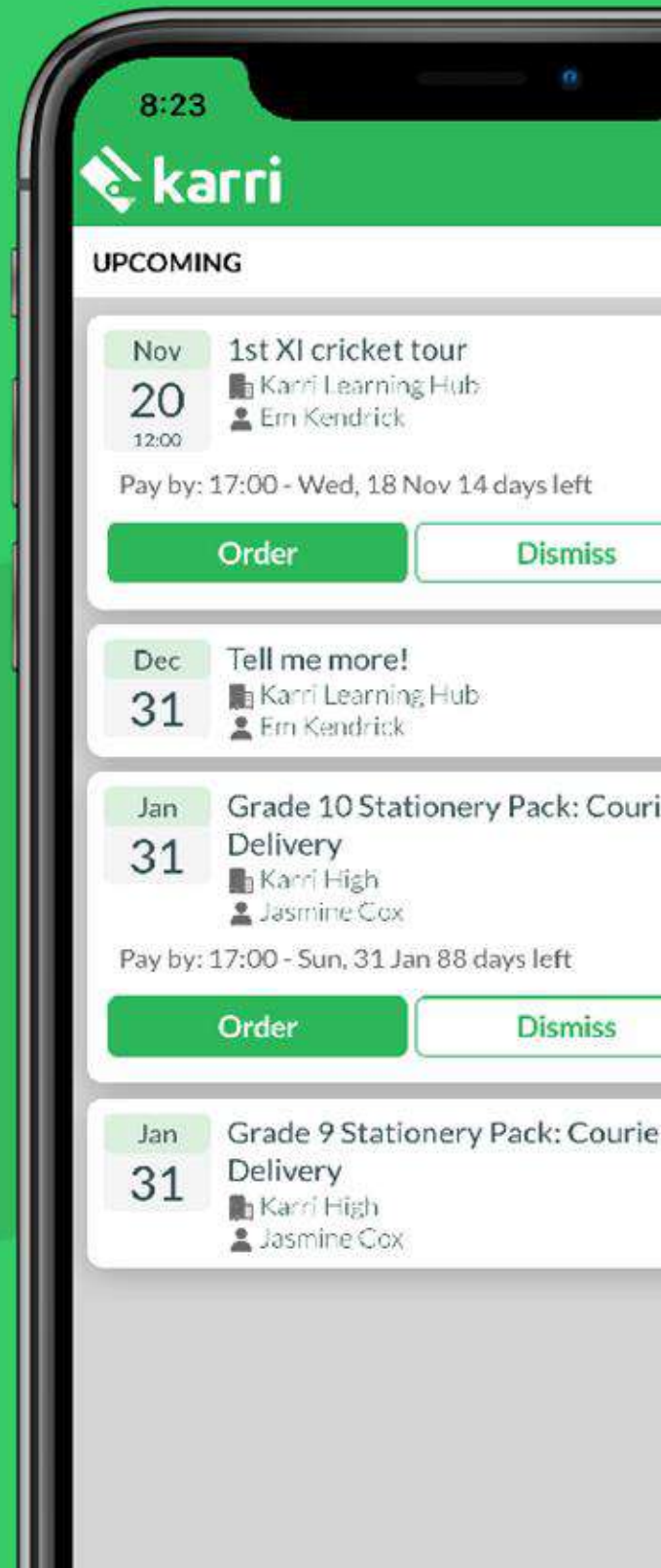

Dear Parents

We are very pleased to introduce you to the **Karri Card**.

### A Mastercard for students

The Karri Card is an innovative and secure way for parents to manage their child's spending. Children get their name on a bank card and parents get peace of mind through transaction information and controls.

Parents can top-up instantly, block lost cards, reset forgotten PINs and receive spending alerts in real time. Students can pay at South African merchants that accept Mastercard - perfect for purchases **at school** and beyond!

In addition, the Karri Card provides simplicity and control **not offered by a normal bank card**:

- **Sign up easily** without the need for a birth certificate
- Set **daily spending limits**
- Rest easy knowing **inappropriate merchants** such as gambling vendors and liquor retailers are **blocked** (T&Cs for details)
- **Multi-parent functionality** which allows both parents to manage cards

**Opt in process:** Parents who would like a Karri Card will have the option to opt-in via a Karri collection. Please pay for the collection before the closing date to get your card on the distribution day.

**Fees:** Monthly card fees are R39pm for 1 card, R68pm for 2 cards, or R87pm for 3 cards (Incl. VAT). To streamline billing, the first three months will be billed upfront. A 2.5% instant top up fee applies.

**Card distribution:** Cards will be handed out in class or available at reception on the distribution day. Distribution will take place within about 5 working days after the collection closes. Parents will receive an email when cards are ready.

**SA ID required:** Due to local regulations, the Karri Card can only be activated by a parent with a SA ID number. Karri is working to offer the card to international parents in the future.

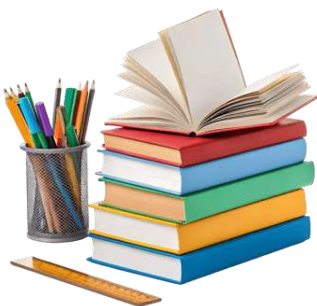

## Code of Conduct - Learners

Grade RR - 7 parents and learners are please to take note of the following provisions in the Code of Conduct for Learners, pages 12 and 15 of the AMPS Homework Diary:



### **Section A: School Uniform**

1. Girls --official summer School Uniform = School dress, white School anklets (above the ankle), standard black shoes with black shoelaces or a strap with a buckle.
2. Girls may wear navy short ski pants underneath their dresses - these may not be visible. No boxer shorts to be worn underneath the dress.
3. Learners may wear a plain navy sun hat / cap during the summer months only, but it must be taken off indoors.
4. Boys -- official summer School Uniform = navy shorts, white shirt with badge, navy School socks with red/white/blue stripe, standard black school shoes with black shoelaces.
5. Winter uniform is the same for both boys and girls. Long navy trousers, long sleeved white School shirt, navy School socks and standard black School shoes as per number 1 and 4 above.
6. Girls may wear navy blue woollen stockings with their School dress and School jersey, during winter only.

Parents and learners are reminded that summer uniform will still be applicable in the month of April. The School will move over to winter uniform in the month of May.



### **Section I: Punctuality**

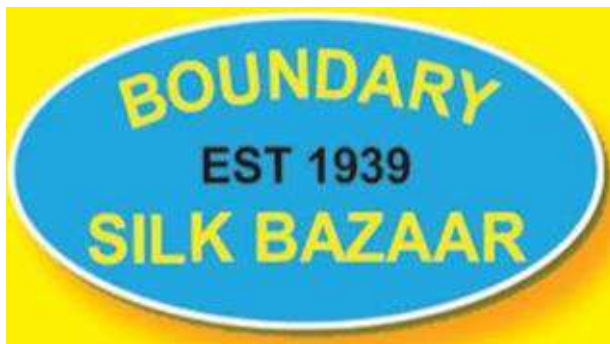
1. The school day is carefully planned to maximize the time available for teaching and extra - murals. Late arrivals to class cause undesirable disruption of the teaching process, as well as other School activities. Consequently, learners must arrive at the set time for commencement of School each day, including each class activity and assembly. The learner must furnish a note from his / her parents explaining late arrival for the commencement of School.
2. Five (5) Points will be deducted from a learner's House (Apollo, Gemini, Mariner) when he / she is a regular latecomer.

*Key Details About International Children's Book Day:*

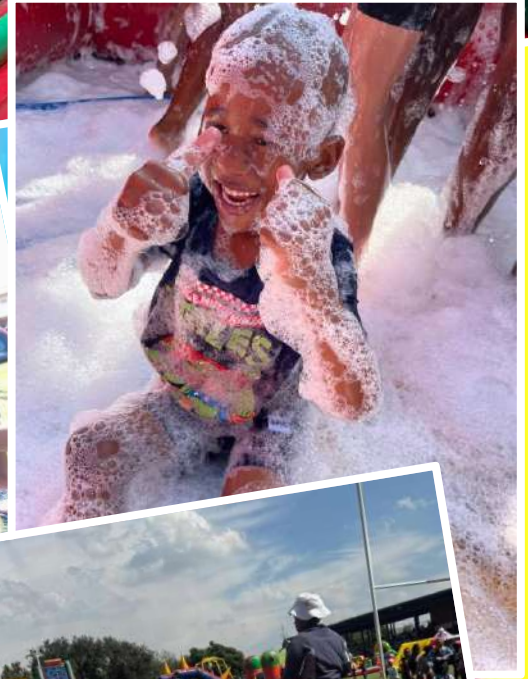
- **Purpose:** To promote children's books, encourage reading, and draw attention to literacy.

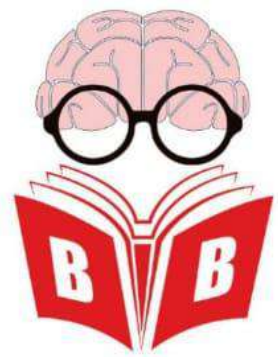

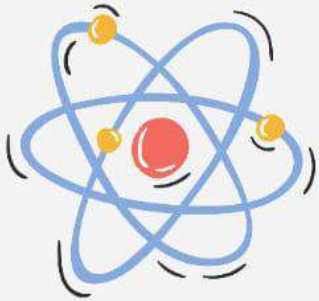
