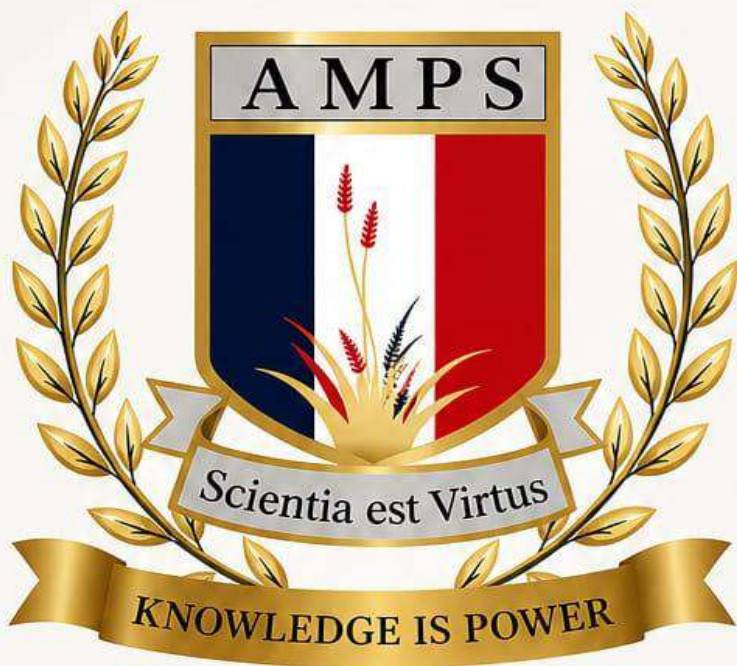

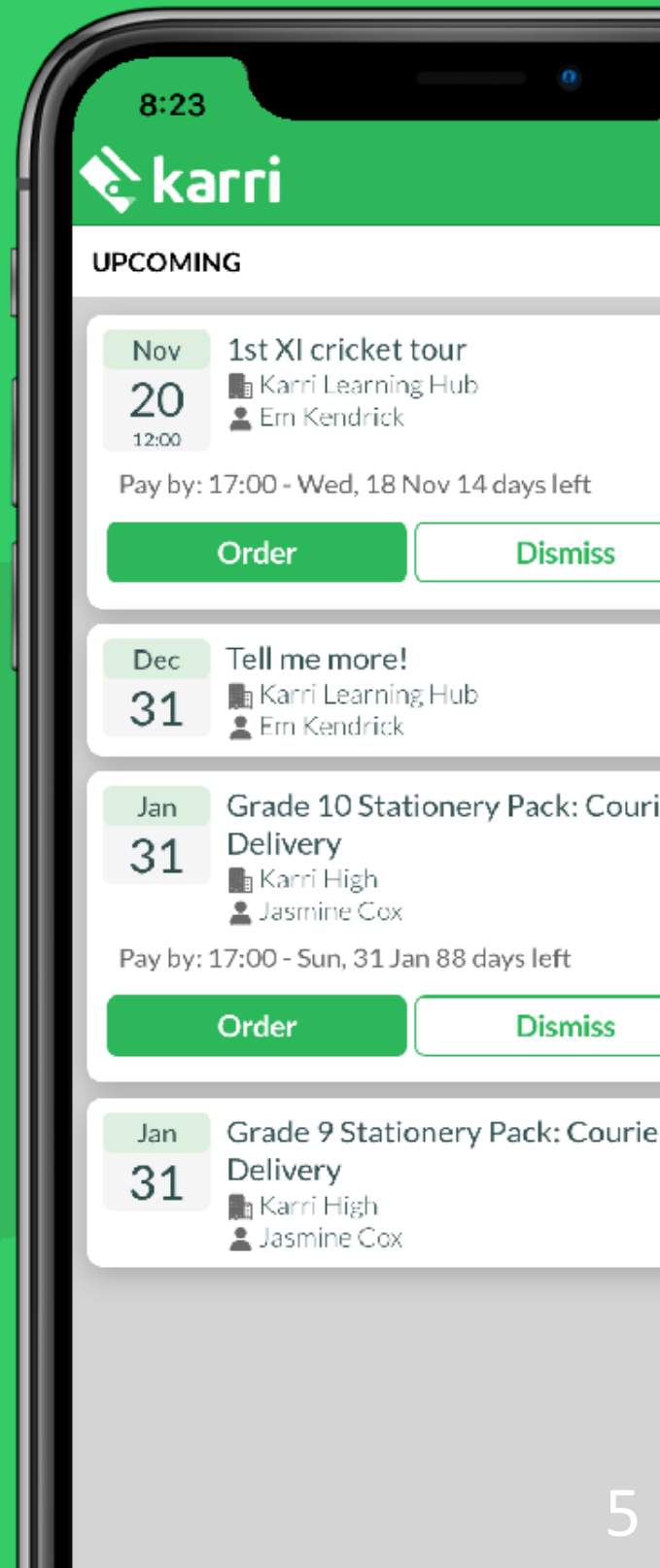

Dear Parents

We are very pleased to introduce you to the **Karri Card**.

A Mastercard for students

The Karri Card is an innovative and secure way for parents to manage their child's spending. Children get their name on a bank card and parents get peace of mind through transaction information and controls.

Parents can top-up instantly, block lost cards, reset forgotten PINs and receive spending alerts in real time. Students can pay at South African merchants that accept Mastercard - perfect for purchases **at school** and beyond!

In addition, the Karri Card provides simplicity and control **not offered by a normal bank card**:

- **Sign up easily** without the need for a birth certificate
- Set **daily spending limits**
- Rest easy knowing **inappropriate merchants** such as gambling vendors and liquor retailers are **blocked** (T&Cs for details)
- **Multi-parent functionality** which allows both parents to manage cards

Opt in process: Parents who would like a Karri Card will have the option to opt-in via a Karri collection. Please pay for the collection before the closing date to get your card on the distribution day.

Fees: Monthly card fees are R39pm for 1 card, R68pm for 2 cards, or R87pm for 3 cards (Incl. VAT). To streamline billing, the first three months will be billed upfront. A 2.5% instant top up fee applies.

Card distribution: Cards will be handed out in class or available at reception on the distribution day. Distribution will take place within about 5 working days after the collection closes. Parents will receive an email when cards are ready.

SA ID required: Due to local regulations, the Karri Card can only be activated by a parent with a SA ID number. Karri is working to offer the card to international parents in the future.

Code of Conduct - Learners

Grade RR - 7 learners are to please take note of the following provisions in the Code of Conduct for Learners, pages 23 and 24 of the AMPS Homework Diary:

Section O: Misconduct and Disciplinary Steps

Schedule 2 - page 23

(SERIOUS MISCONDUCT THAT MAY LEAD TO EXPULSION)



A learner will be guilty of serious misconduct if he or she -

- a). is found guilty of serious misconduct as contemplated in Schedule 1 after having been found guilty of the same or similar misconduct on two previous occasions;
- b). fails to comply with a punishment of suspension as a correctional measure; or
- c). intentionally and without just excuse –
 - i). forges any document or signature to the potential or actual prejudice of the School;
 - ii). trades in any test or examination material;
 - iii). attempts to bribe or bribes any person in respect of any test or examination;
 - iv). engages in fraud;
 - v). engages in theft, or otherwise acts dishonestly to the prejudice of another person;
 - vi). is in the possession of, consumes or deals in any illegal substance;
 - vii). is in possession of, uses or transmits narcotic or unauthorised drugs;
 - viii). is in possession of any dangerous weapon;
 - ix). assaults or threatens to assault another person;
 - x). holds any person hostage;
 - xi). murders any person;
 - xii). rapes any person, or engages in any sexual activity which amounts to an offence in law: or
 - xiii). maliciously damages property.

My responsibility: What must I do?

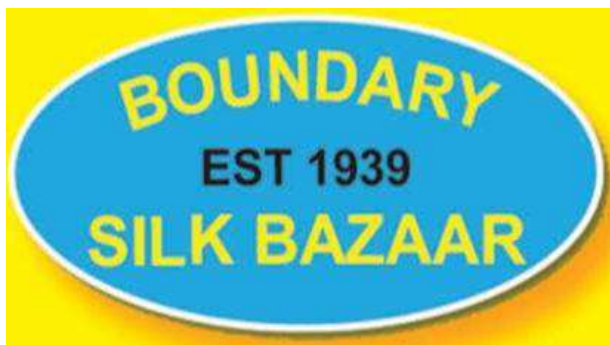
1. I have the responsibility to behave in a way that ensures an emotionally and physically safe environment for others.

The history of comic books

The Timeline of Comic Books

- **Pre-Comics (1800s):** Swiss caricaturist Rodolphe Töpffer is widely recognized as the father of sequential art, publishing one of the earliest story-based comic books, *The Adventures of Obadiah Oldbuck*, in 1842.
- **The Golden Age (1938–1954):** Kicked off by the debut of Superman in *Action Comics #1* (1938). This era focused on costumed heroes fighting in World War II.
- **The Silver Age (1956–1970s):** Brought the return of superheroes and the creation of relatable, complex characters like Spider-Man, the Hulk, and the X-Men, spearheaded by Marvel creators like Stan Lee.
- **The Bronze Age (1970s–1985):** A darker, socially conscious era that tackled real-world issues (such as racism) and brought gritty realism to the forefront.

The Modern Age (1986–Present): Defined by groundbreaking, mature titles like *Watchmen* and *The Dark Knight Returns*, transitioning comics into defined, complex narrative forms and massive Hollywood adaptations.



Key Facts and Records

- **The Most Expensive Comic:** A pristine copy of *Action Comics #1* (the first appearance of Superman) holds the record for the world's most expensive comic book, having sold at private auction for well over 6 million.
- **The Comic Controversy:** In the 1950s, comics were widely blamed for juvenile delinquency due to violent and horror-based stories. This led to the creation of the Comics Code Authority, a strict self-censorship board that controlled the industry for decades.
- **Global Influence:** Manga (Japanese comics) and Manhwa (Korean comics) boast vastly different industry structures and narrative paces from American comics, yet they dominate the global comic book market share.
- **Comics and Graphic Novels:** While comic books are typically short, serialized pamphlets published monthly, graphic novels are longer, self-contained, bound stories that are typically read like traditional novels.

How It Works

- **The Format:** It operates via a dedicated mobile application. Students read texts and take comprehension and speed assessments, requiring at least a 70% comprehension score to advance.
- **The Progression:** The contest takes students through multiple levels—from school and regional online rounds all the way to a prestigious national final.
- **The Prizes:** The competition incentivizes participation by offering major rewards, including laptops, cash prizes for teachers, and funding for winning schools.

What is Reading Riot?

Reading Riot is a structured, app-based literacy competition designed to improve reading fluency and comprehension. Primarily aimed at Grade 6 learners in South Africa, the initiative challenges students through multiple online rounds, before culminating in live, in-person provincial and national finals.

Main Goals

- **Tackling Literacy Challenges:** It directly addresses foundational literacy issues by turning silent reading into an exciting, competitive activity.
- **Skill Development:** The program is designed to build vocabulary, reading confidence, and long-term academic success.

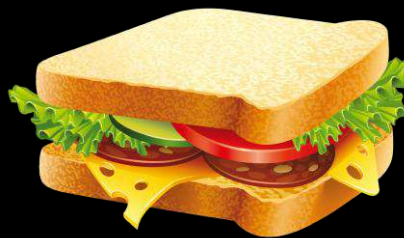

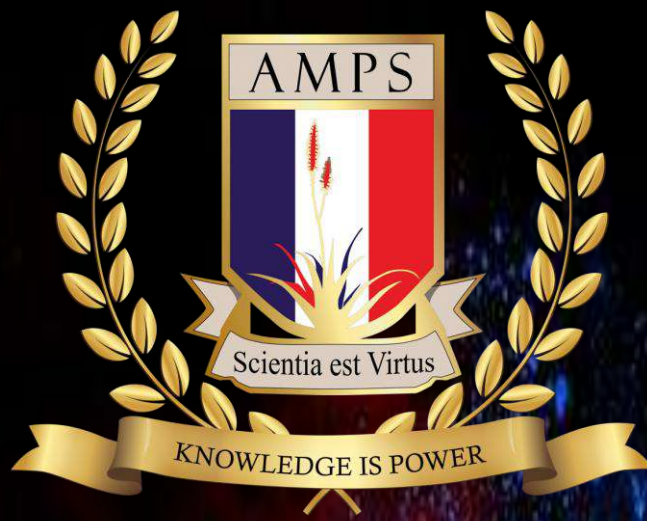
