Code of Conduct – Learners

Grade RR - 7 parents and learners are to please take note of the following provisions in the Code of Conduct for Learners, pages 17 and 21 of the AMPS Homework Diary:

Section L: Conduct - General

15. Learners must display courtesy, good manners and respect to staff members, fellow learners, parents and the public at all times. Bullying and racism in any form will not be tolerated. If experiencing any form of the above mentioned - do not retaliate in any way but report the incident to the class teacher / teacher on duty or the office as soon as possible. A formal disciplinary hearing can be conducted to determine if the incident constitutes bullying or racism.

16. Foodstuffs may not be eaten in classrooms, toilets, the hall or on the corridors, staircases, tarred and paved areas.

17. No chewing of bubble gum is allowed, even on "casual" days.

18. NO littering of any kind is allowed. All litter is to be disposed of in the blue bins. Papers are always to be picked up.

19. Learners must obey the scholar patrol when crossing the road and must cross the street at the marked off crossings in controllable groups.



Section O: Misconduct and Disciplinary Steps

5. Procedure for hearing of serious Misconduct

5.1 A learner charged with serious Misconduct is entitled to a hearing adjudication upon by the disciplinary committee.

5.2 A learner charged with serious Misconduct must be given no less than 5 (five) School days written notice of the hearing into the alleged misconduct, unless -

(a). the governing body directs, with good cause, that a shorter notice period shall apply; and

(b). There is no prejudice caused to the learner by the shorter notice period.

5.3 The notice contemplated in subparagraph (2) must -

(a). Contain sufficient particulars of the date, place and nature of the alleged serious misconduct to enable the learner to identify the incident in question and to respond thereto;

(b). inform the learner of the charge, place, date and time of the hearing.

(c). Inform the learner of provisional suspension, if any, the reasons therefore and any other matter required in connection with the provisional suspension; and

(d). Inform the learner of the rights of a learner in terms thereof.



5.4 The principal must give the notice contemplated in subparagraph (2) to the learner and deliver a copy thereof to the parents of the learner at the address of the learner as indicated in the School register.

5.5 At least one of the parents of the learner must accompany the learner at the hearing, unless the learner is 21 years or older.

5.6 If a member of the disciplinary committee, the learner, his or her representative or a witness requires an interpreter, the disciplinary committee may not proceed with the hearing until an interpreter competent in the relevant language, has been made available.

5.7 If the learner fails to appear before the disciplinary committee after due notice in terms of subparagraph (2) and without just cause for not attending the hearing, the hearing may continue in the absence of the learner.

5.8 The disciplinary committee must keep a full and accurate record of all proceedings before it.

5.9 The prosecutor must commence proceedings at the hearing by setting out the charge against the learner and thereafter presenting the case against the learner.

5.10 The chairperson of the disciplinary committee must ask the learner whether the learner pleads guilty or not guilty to the charge. The learner must respond thereto. Should the learner fail to respond, the learner will be deemed to have pleaded not guilty to the charge.

A Mastercard for students

The Karri Card is an innovative and secure way for parents to manage their child's spending. Children get their name on a bank card and parents get peace of mind through transaction information and controls.

Parents can top-up instantly, block lost cards, reset forgotten PINs and receive spending alerts in real time. Students can pay at South African merchants that accept Mastercard - perfect for purchases **at school** and beyond!

In addition, the Karri Card provides simplicity and control **not offered by a normal bank card**:

- **Sign up easily** without the need for a birth certificate
- Set **daily spending limits**
- Rest easy knowing **inappropriate merchants** such as gambling vendors and liquor retailers are **blocked** (T&Cs for details)
- **Multi-parent functionality** which allows both parents to manage cards

Opt in process: Parents who would like a Karri Card will have the option to opt-in via a Karri collection. Please pay for the collection before the closing date to get your card on the distribution day.

Fees: Monthly card fees are R39pm for 1 card, R68pm for 2 cards, or R87pm for 3 cards (Incl. VAT). To streamline billing, the first three months will be billed upfront. A 2.5% instant top up fee applies.

Card distribution: Cards will be handed out in class or available at reception on the distribution day. Distribution will take place within about 5 working days after the collection closes. Parents will receive an email when cards are ready.

SA ID required: Due to local regulations, the Karri Card can only be activated by a parent with a SA ID number. Karri is working to offer the card to international parents in the future.
