Code of Conduct – Learners

Grade RR - 7 learners and parents are to please take note of the following provisions in the Code of Conduct for Learners, pages 18 & 19 of the AMPS Homework Diary:

Section L: Conduct - General



40. Learners are to leave the school grounds immediately after School and on the completion of extramural activities. Learners may not loiter and sit on pavements. Parents must ensure that learners are fetched promptly after School or on the completion of extra mural activities. Learners must enter and exit the school premises from the following gates; Oorbietjie, Njala and Eland Street Hall gate, before and after School. Learners are not ALLOWED to use the Visitor's gate and the Vehicle gate in Eland Street or enter and exit through the school office reception area. ONLY latecomers and visitors must use the visitor's gate in Eland Street. All gates will be locked at 07:30am

41. Learners are not allowed to ride bicycles, skateboards etc. on the school property. Skateboards are prohibited on school property as well as on the roads around the school.

42. Children may not leave the school property to go to a shop before or after School. Parents must fetch / drop children on time to assure their safety. The school will not be held liable for any injuries caused.

43. The principal or an educator, upon reasonable suspicion (sufficient information), has legal authority to conduct a search of any learner or property in possession of the learner, for a dangerous weapon, firearm, cigarettes, vape, drugs or harmful dangerous substances, stolen property, or pornographic material brought onto the school property. (A search may be performed in terms of the following Acts of general application: Control of Access to Public Premises and Vehicles Act, 1985, Act No. 53 of 1985; Drugs and Drug Trafficking Act 140 of 1992; Arms and Ammunition Act, 1969, Act No. 75 of 1969). During a search, human dignity shall be observed, and learners shall be searched in private by persons of their own gender, preferably in the presence of at least one other person. A record must be kept of all search proceedings and the outcome.

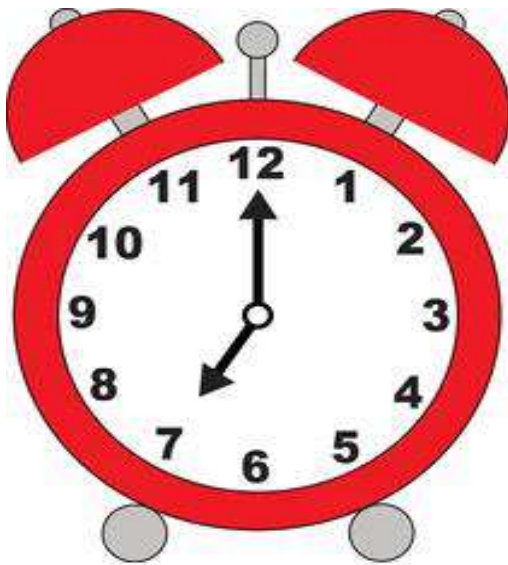
44. No learner should engage in any physical contact, eg. hugging, kissing, holding hands, wrestling, etc.

Dear Parents

We are very pleased to introduce you to the **Karri Card**.

A Mastercard for students

The Karri Card is an innovative and secure way for parents to manage their child's spending. Children get their name on a bank card and parents get peace of mind through transaction information and controls.

Parents can top-up instantly, block lost cards, reset forgotten PINs and receive spending alerts in real time. Students can pay at South African merchants that accept Mastercard - perfect for purchases **at school** and beyond!

In addition, the Karri Card provides simplicity and control **not offered by a normal bank card**:

- **Sign up easily** without the need for a birth certificate
- Set **daily spending limits**
- Rest easy knowing **inappropriate merchants** such as gambling vendors and liquor retailers are **blocked** (T&Cs for details)
- **Multi-parent functionality** which allows both parents to manage cards

Opt in process: Parents who would like a Karri Card will have the option to opt-in via a Karri collection. Please pay for the collection before the closing date to get your card on the distribution day.

Fees: Monthly card fees are R39pm for 1 card, R68pm for 2 cards, or R87pm for 3 cards (Incl. VAT). To streamline billing, the first three months will be billed upfront. A 2.5% instant top up fee applies.

Card distribution: Cards will be handed out in class or available at reception on the distribution day. Distribution will take place within about 5 working days after the collection closes. Parents will receive an email when cards are ready.

SA ID required: Due to local regulations, the Karri Card can only be activated by a parent with a SA ID number. Karri is working to offer the card to international parents in the future.
